Title: Approving Settlement of Disputed Real Estate Assessment (Omni Hotel)

(2nd reading)

Background

In March 2021 the Omni Charlottesville Virginia Corporation ("Omni") filed an action in the Charlottesville Circuit Court, challenging the City's real estate assessment for Tax Year 2020; subsequently, the lawsuit was amended to include a challenge to the City's real estate assessment for Tax Year 2021. The Omni currently has an appeal pending before the City's Board of Equalization (BOE) challenging its real estate assessment for Tax Year 2022.

Discussion

Over the course of the past year, attorneys for the Omni and for the City (the law firm of Gentry Locke) have engaged in mutual discussions regarding the challenged assessments. At this time the parties have reached a tentative settlement agreement, which would not become effective unless approved by action of City Council.
